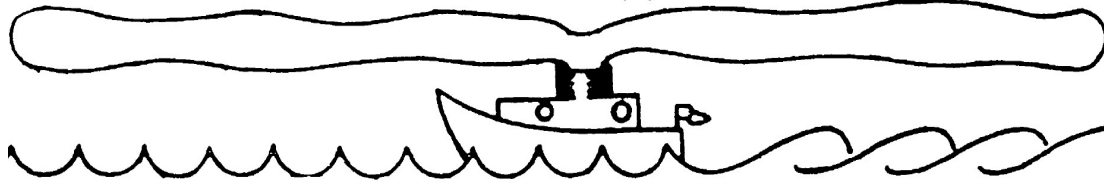

IMIS Migration Information

The migration to the iMIS system is continuing. You can now perform the following operations on the Member Portal:

- Pay your dues
- Update your member information, including street addresses, email addresses and alternate email addresses
- Change your Member Portal password. (On the

Member Website, you will still log in with your PIN and certificate number.)

- Print dues notices
- Add new members
- Enter OD information for squadrons and districts using Committee Admin privileges
- New cyber members can register and join
- National Committee member additions/removals coming soon. (HQ 229) Please send all changes to Lena Padro at Headquarters.

The following services remain unavailable on the USPS Member site:

- Updating class and seminar completions
- Assignment and updates to squadron and district officers and committee chairs
- Processing of OD-1/OD-2 entries and Change-of-Watch

Please enter OD information on both the member portal and the member website until further notice.

- Assignment and updates to USPS National Committees (HQ 229); please also send any changes to Lena Padro at Headquarters as this data doesn't transfer.
